Course duration: 36 hours

Course Synopsis

Place of work such as; workshops and factories is considered an unnatural environment in terms of high temperature, dangerous machineries, toxic substances, flammable liquids, compressed gases, etc, and occupational safety is the responsibility of everyone working in such environment and any safety misbehavior on anyone's part could bring serious injury or even death to themselves or others working near by.

Occupational safety is as important as production and for a company to survive it should find ways to avoid loss and not to maximize profit. This could only be achieved by investing in SAFETY.

The primary emphasis of this workshop is to introduce the attendees to the basic elements of Industrial Safety in the workplace in an attempt to change their attitude, which could lead to changing their behaviors toward safety.

This workshop targets managers, supervisors, safety staff, technicians and others interested in learning about safety and health at the workplace.
