The PMP exam consists of 200 questions made up of 175 'live' questions and 25 pre-test questions. The pre-test questions are scattered randomly throughout the exam and do not influence your score (they are there to validate the question for use in future exams). However, you have no way of knowing which questions are pre-test and which are 'live' and need to deal with all 200 questions in the same way! The current pass mark is 61%, this is an overall score from the 175 'live' questions (106 correct) there are no minimum requirements in each domain. The structure of the exam is:-
